



Prof. Ir. Frederik Josep Putuhena M.Sc., Ph.D. began his professional carrier as Tutor at University of Indonesia, and promoted as lecturer for Water Resources Engineering in 1976. He received British Council Award for study at University of Newcastle upon Tyne, UK, and received Master of Science in Engineering Hydrology.
